

Mittleuropa Blasmusikfest 2014. 24.04. - 27.04. Split



International Association "Centraleuropean Action - Movement for Cultural Cooperation of Central Europe" (CEA-MCE) and sponsor awards, the company Euro - Unit /Croatia from April 24 to 27 2014. held Fifth International Festival of Central European wind music. The Festival was attended by a total of 12 wind orchestras with about 650 participants from Italy, Austria, Slovenia and Croatian (Dalmatia, Istria, Croatian Zagorje and Medjimurje). The festival was a competition, and orchestras were classified into four value categories, A, B, C and E. Each orchestra has performed at three compositions, namely: introduction, mandatory and composition at the free choice.

The fifth member of the Jury, Mr. Manuel Epli, who had also previously served as the Chairperson of the Jury, was delayed and could not participate, because of the car accident he was involved in during his trip en route to Croatia.

Each member of the Jury gave his/hers individual grade for the entire performance of each orchestra and the final number of points of an orchestra is a standard average of these grades.

The success of the wind brass orchestras issued in points (and for places I. to III. In writing) according the given grades of the International Jury is set as in table below:
